STEM YEA VOLUNTEERS

The 2023 STEM YEA program will require adult volunteers to help supervise, monitor, guide, and assist STEM YEA students during their time at the Academy. The program will need volunteers throughout the 80-hour time frame of the Academy from **Thursday through Sunday evening (July 6th to July 9th)**, including daytime, evening, and overnight hours.

We need volunteers to help with registering students the 1st day of the Academy (Thursday morning early afternoon) which includes help setting up the registration table and manning various stations throughout the college to direct students' parents to the parking lot, the registration site, and to the dormitories, along with help in the dormitories to get the students situated into their correct room assignments.

During the Academy sessions, volunteers generally will be with the students a good portion of the day. Most of the volunteer contact will occur in group settings, but there may be times where a pair of STEM YEA volunteers needs to take / assist a student to go to another campus building or area possible for medical attention, to pick up an item that was forgotten/left behind at some location, or for some other reason. **Overnight volunteers** will be responsible for monitoring the students on the dormitory floor. (Overnight volunteers will be assigned a room).

In addition, **we will need volunteers to help with the final day's celebratory dinner event** (Sunday 3:00PM to 8:00PM), manning various stations on the college campus to direct students' parents, business sponsors and guests to the parking lot and to the event location, assisting with setup of event decorations, etc.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETING THE VOLUNTEER SIGN UP FORM

The initial 2023 STEM YEA VOLUNTEER SIGN-UP FORM is 1 page, which contains contact information about the volunteer (you or another person that you are registering to be a volunteer). Enter your Email address in the first field. The remaining fields relate to the volunteer (which may be you or the person you are registering).

Once you have completed the information, press the **SUBMIT** button to record your entry. (No data is saved unless you press the **SUBMIT** button.) **An email will be sent to you confirming** the information you entered. This email contains an **EDIT RESPONSE** button that allows you to reenter the form and modify your information. **So, please keep this email as it will allow you to re-access the sign-up form.**

The first email will be from STEMYEA2022@gmail.com with instructions using personal records on file to complete volunteer eligibility requirements. The second email will be directly from **OneSource**, a required yearly background check when working with youth in D7430. Once all YP requirements are submitted and approved, the volunteer and the STEM YEA Chair will be notified

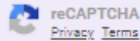
